Resolution on Our Support of the Nation of Israel
October 8-9, 2007

WHEREAS we live in a day when the nation of Israel is surrounded by her enemies and lives under the burden of their threats and attacks; and

Because the rest of the world increasingly is placed pressure on Israel to accommodate her neighbors through concessions of the land and treaties which leave her defenseless; and

Because many Church leaders today are also pressuring the governments toward "balanced policies" favoring Israel's enemies; and

Because the people of Israel are God's special people (Deuteronomy 7:6), with special promises in His Sovereign plan for the future (Romans 11); and

Because God has promised to bless them who bless Israel (Genesis 12:3), and challenged us to pray for Israel (Psalm 122:6;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the messengers in fellowship with the Nebraska Association of Regular Baptist Churches meeting for our 50th Annual Fall Conference in Fullerton, Nebraska, October 8-9, 2007, although we do not endorse every act or word of the Israeli government, do reaffirm our support for the nation and people of Israel; and

We urge pastors and congregations to teach the special place Israel holds in Scripture and the promises God has made to Israel regarding her land and future; and

We urge pastors and congregations to support Israel in their conversations with people in general and wit elected officials in particular; and

We urge pastors and congregation to pray for the protection, peace, and salvatoin of Israel until the Lord catches up His Church.
